Blue Ribbon Unit Program

(For your information only – No need to return to Council)

Free badges of rank have been provided to qualified Central Florida Council Scouting Units since January 1, 1989. The budget committee of the Council is delighted to continue this service. Free badges of rank will be furnished by the Council to units that meet the following criteria.

Requirements

1. Be a "Journey to Excellence" Silver or Gold Unit.
2. Participate in the Council Scout Show (*Must sell a minimum of \$500 in total sales*) and have a booth.
3. FOS presentation held at Blue & Gold or Court of Honor.
4. Participate in Scouting for Food.
5. Participate in the Council Popcorn Sale (*Must sell a minimum of \$500 in total sales*).
6. Recharter completed and turned in by December 1st.

Key Points

- A unit qualifies as a Blue Ribbon Unit when they have completed all six items. Qualifications are evaluated monthly.
- In the Boy Scout Program – Badges of rank include: Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, Life, and Eagle.
- In the Cub Scout Program – Badges of rank include: Bobcat, Wolf, Bear, Webelos, and Arrow of Light.
- Any unit that is not a Blue Ribbon Unit will need to pay for Summertime Pack Award, World Conservation, Emergency Preparedness and National Den Award materials.

Not Included in the Blue Ribbon Program:

- Merit badges, arrow points, badges of office, activity pins and replacement badges.
